

Israel Tourist Visa

• Original Passport with old Passport:

 Note: Passport should be valid minimum 09 months from the date of travel, Passport has been issued within 10 years and validity must not exceed 10 years, no hand written passports will be accepted.

Photograph:

o 02 Recent Photograph (5 x 5 cm size, white background, matt finish & 80% face image & not used in previous visa).

Financials:

- o 01 years Personal Income Tax Returns with computation of Total Income Page.
- o 06 months Personal original Bank Statement updated with sufficient balance and Bank seal and signature.

• For Employee:

- o Pay Slip (last 6 months).
- Leave sanction letter and N.O.C.
- o G.P.F (for Government Employee).
- Personal cover letter stating purpose of travel

• For Self-Employed:

- o Business letterhead with sign & stamp & visiting card.
- Business Proof (Shop & Establishment, G.S.T., C.S.T., etc).
- o Partnership Deed.
- Memorandum of Article.
- o 01 Years Income Tax Return with computation of Total Income Page.
- 06 months Personal original Bank Statement with Bank seal and signature on A4 size paper
- Personal cover letter stating purpose of travel on company/business letter head

• For Retired:

- Retirement letter from Employer.
- Pension passbook copy.
- o Provident Funds copy.

• For Student:

- o Certificate of Enrolment or Letter of Acceptance from School
- o College and university or photo I D Card copy.
- o Child travel below 18 years birth certificate copy.

Hotel Confirmation Voucher

- Ticket Booking
- Tour Itinerary with Confirmation Letter (If You Are Taking A Schedule Tour)
- Visa Application Form: Signed by Applicant (Blue Ink)
- PAN card and AADHAR card (Front side and Back side) compulsory.



- Insurance Policy:
 - o Minimum coverage of USD 50000 per person during entire stay in Israel.
- Note: In case of Minor (below 18years) travelling with single parent, both the parents required to come to consulate to sign a declaration form and also need to submit Birth certificate of child.

Visa Process Time: Approx. 08 working days after submission at consulate/embassy.
